We intend the meeting to provide a unique forum for investigators of all relevant areas to discuss their most recent work considered in a pathogenetic and therapeutic perspective. Abstract-driven sessions and poster displays will be the main body of the meeting. Invited speakers for plenary sessions and symposia will update and summarize current information in specific areas of HIV research selected by an international scientific committee.

Since the earliest days of the epidemic, France

and the ANRS have been in the forefront of scientific and medical research in HIV/AIDS. Paris was thus a natural choice for the IAS as the city to host, after Buenos Aires in July 2001, "the 2nd IAS Conference on HIV Pathogenesis and Treatment". This conference will now be held every second year, in the odd years between the International AIDS Conferences.

We look forward to welcoming you in Paris, "la ville des lumières", the city of lights, to share the science, generate novel approaches to fighting HIV disease and bring hope to the world that, despite significant progress, remains increasingly challenged by the AIDS epidemic.

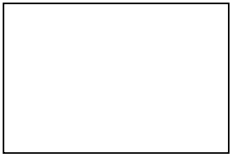
